



Racing Rules

Entry Fees & Award guide lines

02/21/09

- Do not approach judges, scorekeeper (tower) or flagman. Any complaints during any ALQMA event must be directed to the Race Director. ALQMA and QMA Code of Conduct will be enforced.
- All complaints must go to the Race Director within 15 minutes after race
- Concessions must be open and staffed before any racing can begin
- Members/Handlers may not have individuals removed from Judge's Stand
- All cars must scale after each race
- QMA Rules will apply at all times
- Must be ready when it is your race (can't wait for you)
- 20 minute time limit
- Pill draw for position on non point's nights
- Will qualify for position on point's races and club races posted in advance.
- Judges must be used at all times
- Will use paper #'s

- . Rainouts will be called by Track director by 7:30a.m. on Day Races and by 12:00 noon on Night Races prior to sign- ins. Watch the ALQMA web site for cancelations.
- . No Entry Fee Returns after Green Flag has dropped on Racing Surface
- . Race Director may combine classes if necessary
- . Race Director may move "Huggie Pole" if necessary for track conditions and competition

- . Race Fees for Points races are \$20.00 for ALQMA members and non-members
- . Trophies will be awarded at end of night on non point races after tech has been complete if necessary
- . Heat Trophies will only be awarded on non point races. There must be more than one car in class to qualify for heat trophy.
- . Novice class will all receive a minimum of participation award for all feature finishing positions
